- Belt and Road Initiative: China has been investing massively in infrastructure along the former land and maritime Silk Road. A number of concrete examples of the use of the Luxembourg toolbox for BRI projects will be discussed.
- Reforming and opening of the Chinese financial sector: The

  reforms impacting asset management and at the same time is
  opening up to foreign managers which can now create private fund
  management companies or hold the majority of their JVs in China.
   We will discuss these changes, the options available to global
  managers and trends in relation thereto.
